SAFETY

SETTING UP

ADJUST THE HEIGHT OF THE LEGS

Adjust the chair to an appropriate seating height ensuring your feet are touching the floor.

- On each leg, press the spring button and adjust the leg piece to the desired height making sure the shower chair sits level.
- IMPORTANT: Ensure that the spring button is fully engaged in the adjustment hole and the leg does not move

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

- Check condition regularly for wear and tear.
- DO NOT use if the product shows any sign of damage, corrosion or rust.
- Clean the frame and seat with mild soap / detergent and water; wipe dry.
- Do not use abrasive cleaning agents or solvents.
- To prevent rust Dry product completely after use and before storing.
- Spray lubricants will assist in water/moisture displacement and protect from the product from corrosion.
- Store in a dry place when not in use.
