

HANDLING AND SAFETY TIPS

Warning: Wheelchairs are heavy items – ensure proper lifting techniques to avoid injury. Ask for assistance whenever possible.

Be sure your weight is within the load capacity of the unit and the wheelchair is suitable for your needs and abilities. Seek the advice of a suitably trained therapist or carer if uncertain.

Before using the wheelchair, always check to ensure product is in good working condition.

Check brakes are in working order.

Ensure both brakes are applied before getting in or out of the wheelchair.

DO NOT stand on footplates when getting in or out of the wheelchair

Stability

The wheelchair is designed to be safe and stable if centre of gravity is maintained while going about normal activities. Care must be taken while performing activities that shift the centre of gravity in the chair. Never reach so far that it requires you to shift in the seat or bend over out of the chair.

Ramps and Inclines

Be sure of your own capabilities, limitations and strength before attempting to go up a ramp. Correct techniques on ramp negotiation should be demonstrated to you by a qualified professional. Avoid changing direction when going down an incline as this could result in instability or tipping over. Seek assistance where possible

Do not overload the wheelchair

Do not use the wheelchair with the back folded or hang objects on the backrest – this can alter the centre of gravity and could cause the chair to tip backwards

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Check condition regularly for wear and tear.
- Do not use if product shows signs of damage or corrosion.
- Always check bolts and nuts are securely fastened.
- Clean using a slightly damp cloth and wipe dry.
- Lubricate moving parts. We recommend a silicone based lubricant (spray) which will also assist in water / moisture displacement and can help reduce rust / corrosion.
- It is recommended that the wheelchair be serviced at least once a year by a mobility aid specialist.

INSTRUCTIONS

Unfolding the Wheelchair (Figure A)

Hold the handles with both hands to separate the frame slightly. Push down on the side rails of the seat until frame is fully extended.

Folding the Wheelchair (Figure B)

Step 1: Turn up both footplates.

Step 2: Pull up centre of seat from the front and rear and fold closed.

Adjusting the Footplate height (Figure C)

Loosen the locking bolt on the base of the stem (9) with tool provided, slide tubing and adjust the footplate to a suitable height. Tighten bolts to fix in place.

Brake system

Important: Ensure both brakes are applied before getting in or out of wheelchair.

Attendant hand brake (2): Squeeze (pull up) to apply brakes.

Hand brake (Figure D): Push forward (5) to engage park brake. Pull back (5) to release.

Note: DO NOT leave Hand brake (5) engaged as this will cause a permanent indent on the tyre.




Figure D. Hand brake




Figure A. Unfolding

Figure B. Folding




Figure C. Footrest height adjustment
